

ELC Regulations for the establishment of the Student Learning Outcome Enhancement Committee

Article 1

To enhance teaching quality and student learning outcome, the Tunghai English Language Center Student Learning Outcome Enhancement Committee (hereafter referred to as 'the Committee') is established by: Article 8 of the Tunghai University Student Learning Outcome Enhancement Committee regulations and Article 2 of the Tunghai ELC CPRC regulations.

Article 2

The functions of the Committee are as follows:

1. To check the relevance of the educational goals and core competences
2. To check the relevance of educational goals, core competences, and overall curriculum planning.
3. To review and revise the student counseling measures.
4. To review and revise the student learning effectiveness assessment and self-improvement mechanism.
5. To review and revise other issues related to the enhancement of teaching quality and student learning outcomes

Article 3

The Committee is composed of 7 members from the full-time faculty: the Director of the Center, the 2 NECC members, and 4 elected members chosen by the Center Council.

Article 4

The Committee meetings are called by the Center Director. The Chair of this Committee is the Center Director.

Article 5

The Committee shall meet at least once an academic year.

Article 6

Half of the committee members must be present before the meeting can commence. A simple majority (over one-half) of the committee members present at a meeting is required for Committee decisions.

Article 7

The review shall be conducted at least once an academic year and sent to the Center Council and the College Council for discussion. The minutes of the meeting will be sent to the Office of Academic Affairs by the end of October each year for review.

Article 8

The Committee regulations shall be implemented after they have been approved by the Center Council and the College Council and filing for record with the Office of Academic Affairs.

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
