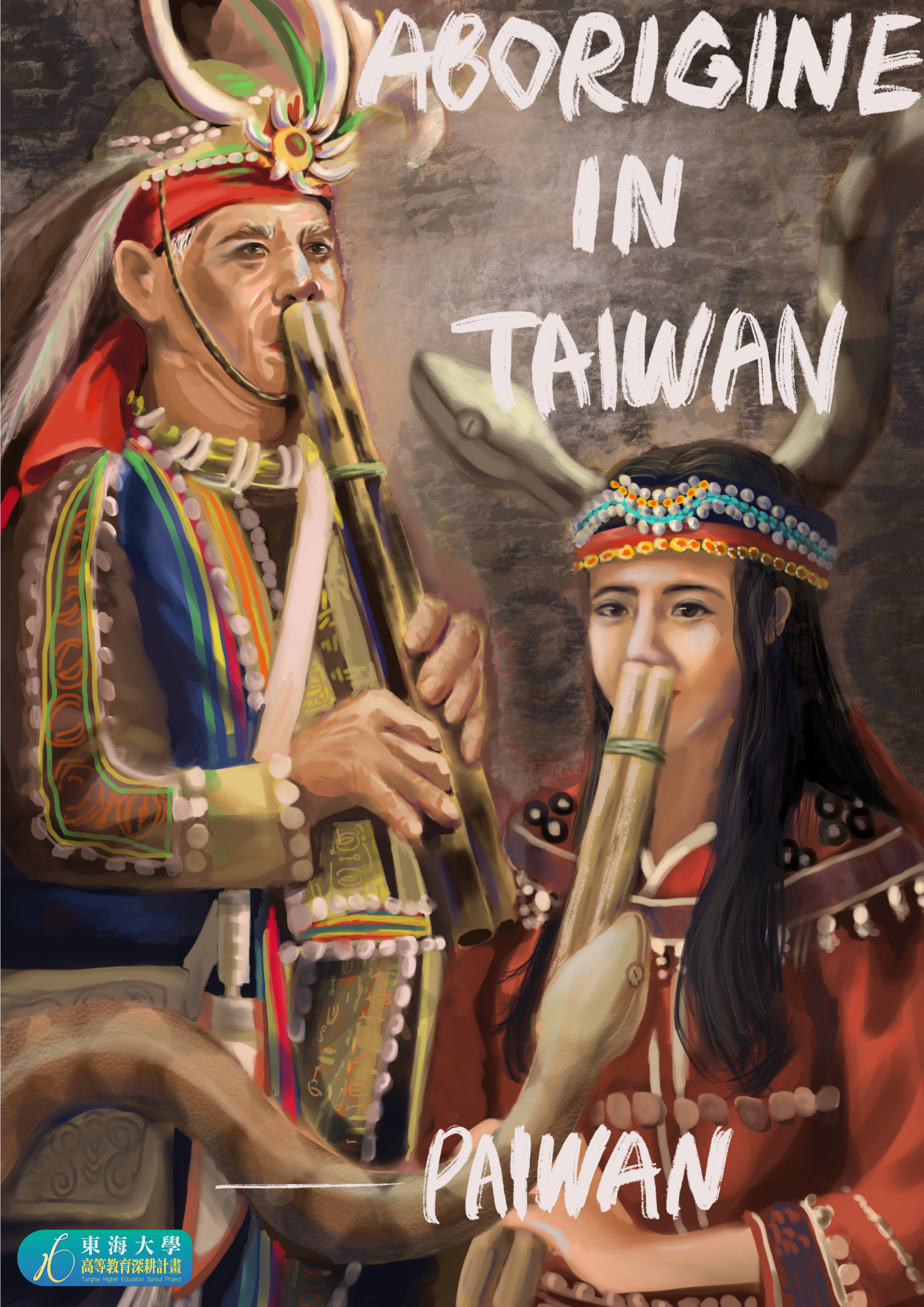

內容簡介 (英 50-100 字) Brief introduction in 50-100 words	<p>Aboriginal culture is one of the indigenous and historical representations in Taiwan, whose aesthetic features and music are worthy to be preserved. There are 16 nationally recognized tribes, having various features and symbols in colors and materials of costumes. They would wear colorful clothes to celebrate festivals such as the harvest festival for Amis, dancing and singing joyfully simultaneously. Besides, the instruments are also unique for creating their own musical style. Among all, I am impressed by the nose flute and characteristics of Paiwan.</p> <p>Paiwan is famous for its nose flute, symbols, and ornaments. They consider the breath coming out of the nose to represent lives, but the mouth may come out with lies. Therefore, nose flutes create music with pure affection.</p> <p>Hundred pace snakes are representative symbols. A hundred pace snake has a similar personality to the leader, which is independent, peaceful, and calm. It contains the hierarchy meaning. The snakes' patterns are only for Paiwan people in the high class. Additionally, they are proud of their myths and legends, embroidering the sun, hundred pace snakes, and human heads in red, yellow, and green colors on the ornaments. Furthermore, powerful men usually hang a bronze knife, wearing a head made of wild boar teeth and bird feathers to show noble status. As it turns out, the patterns and the decorations can be the fanciest among aboriginal ethnic groups.</p> <p>Aboriginal cultures are full of cultural properties, they are the precious treasure in Taiwan.</p>

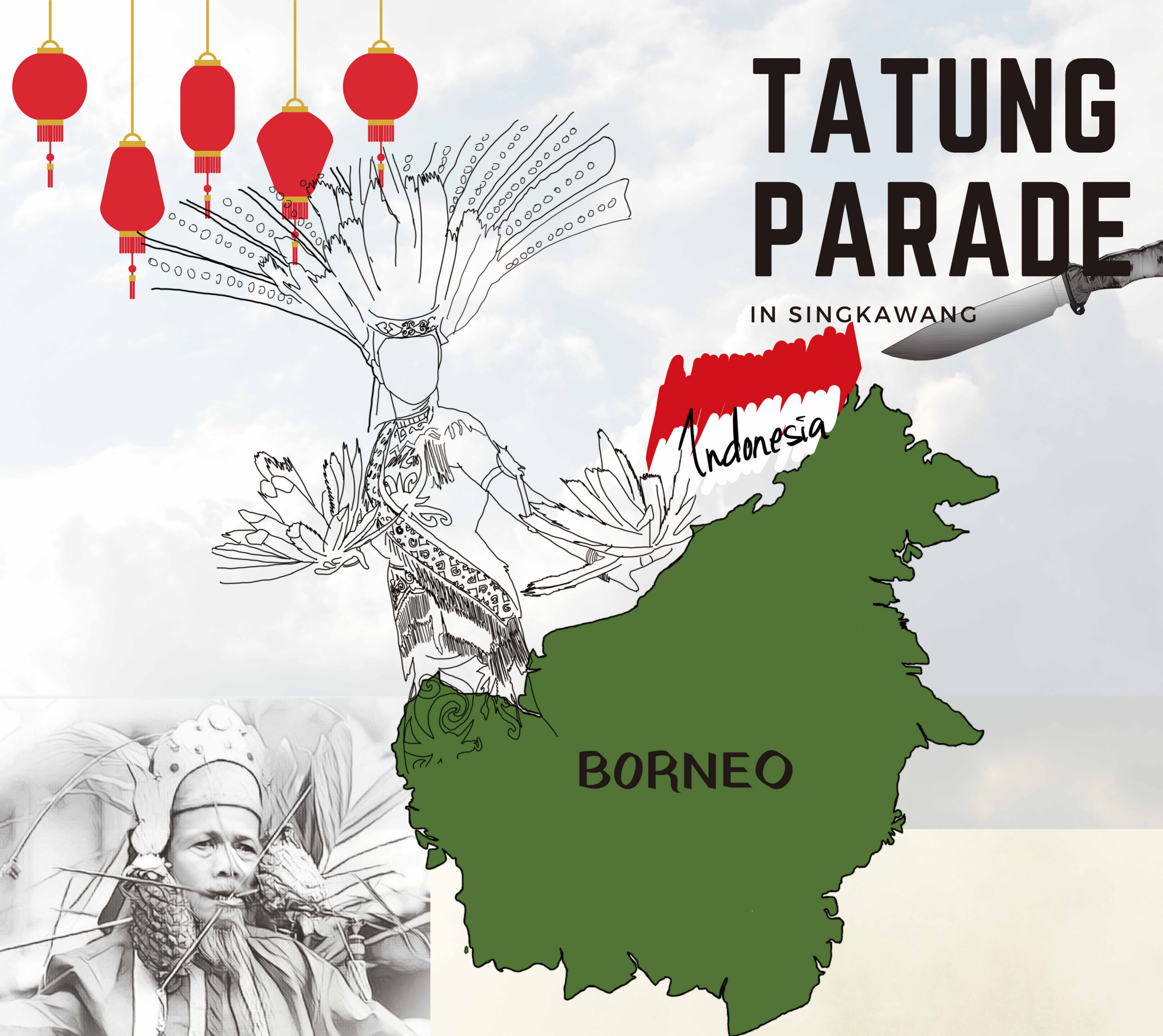
